ORDER

1. In this order:

“the unincorporated charity” means Lympstone Village Hall (269342)

“the CIO” means Lympstone Village Hall CIO (1187640)

“liabilities properly incurred” excludes any liabilities arising from any negligence, default, breach of duty or breach of trust committed by the trustees of the unincorporated charity

2. Being satisfied that it is expedient in the interests of both charities, the Commission authorises the trustees of the unincorporated charity to transfer the assets and liabilities of the unincorporated charity to the CIO and the CIO to receive them, provided that, at the point of transfer, the value of the transferring assets exceeds the value of any transferring liabilities.
3. Being satisfied that it is expedient in the interests of the CIO, the Commission authorises the CIO to grant an indemnity to the trustees of the unincorporated charity provided that indemnity is limited to:
- (a) liabilities properly incurred by the trustees of the unincorporated charity acting in their capacity as such; and
 - (b) the value of the assets transferred by the unincorporated charity to the CIO.
