

LYMPSTONE VILLAGE HALL AUDIO & VIDEO CAPABILITY

MAIN HALL

The audio equipment is housed in a lockable cabinet, our hirers wishing to use the equipment will need to obtain a key from our Technical Team or Premises Manager. Usage instructions and our WiFi access code are on wall notices.

AUDIO

- A 'plug and play' system with five inputs.
- Mobile phone, laptop*, ipad or tablet can be connected using a pre-installed 3.5mm stereo jack cable. (NB - If your 'audio source' has a USB - C or Lightning Connector you will require an adapter)
- Two more inputs allow for additional equipment to be connected, one has an pre-installed 3.5mm stereo jack cable, the other a pre-installed stereo RCA phono cable.
- The fourth input connects to the stage so equipment can be plugged in via a 3.5mm stereo jack along with a 5m extension to allow for positioning of input source either on or in front of the stage.
- A fifth input is available and our Technical Support Team will be able to provide advice or cables according to hirers needs.
- When more than one device is used, the system has the facility to normalise volume between the different inputs.
- A graphic equaliser enables users to tailor the sound to specific requirements.
- Two microphones are pre-installed with the flexibility of using either a Lavalier (tie-clip) or headset, both provided. Three additional microphone inputs are available.
- Sound from the Main Hall can be relayed simultaneously to both the Function Room and Committee Room. (If this is required The Technical Team will need to set up accordingly)

VIDEO

- Ceiling mounted projector with HDMI input capability may be connected from either the stage or the back of the hall.
- A 5m extension cable at the stage end allows for positioning of the input source either on or in front of the stage.
- Above the stage is a ceiling mounted motorised dropdown screen.

** Please note that some older laptops will not recognise a 3.5mm stereo jack audio output cable when an HDMI cable is connected for video and will require a setting adjustment, our Technical Team can help.*
